



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Do teams have to change sides at half time?

**YES.** The **ONLY** exception is the middle field (2) at Soccerplexe Catalogna.

### Which team must wear pinnies if there is a color clash?

The team on the **LEFT** side on the gamesheet.

### May a player get on the field if he/she arrives after halftime?

**NO.** To be eligible, a player must arrive before the start of the second half.

### How many yellows must one player receive before a 1 game suspension?

2 yellow cards in one game will result in a 1-game suspension.

If a player receives **3** yellow cards in the same season, he/she will automatically be suspended for the following game.

If a player receives **5** yellow cards in the same season, he/she will automatically be suspended for the following **2 games**.

### Until when are we eligible to add new players to the roster?

Right up until your team's 14th **GAME**. After which, you are not permitted to add new players.

### How many games must be played to be eligible for playoffs?

A player must partake in 4 league games to be eligible for playoffs.

### Can a player transfer to another team in the same division during an ongoing season?

A player may change teams in the same division during an ongoing season only if they are on **GOOD TERMS** with the original team. This means that the player must be up to date with their payments to the original team and must return the team uniform (if applicable). Once the team change is approved by QSL management, the player in question must purge the following two games before being eligible to play.

### Are Division 1 players eligible to play in other divisions?

A division 1 player (**one who has played in over three division 1 games**) can play as many games as they like in the division directly adjacent to them (in this case division 2).

**FOR WOMEN ONLY\*** However, only **ONE** division 1 player **may be on a division 3 or 4 game sheet at a time**. This rule also includes GOALIES.

### Is there a mercy rule?

If there is a differential of 10 goals during a game, the game will officially be over. The teams may continue to play for the remainder of their playing time if they wish. The goals and assists will cease to officially count, but all additional cautions and expulsions will be counted.
